Qualifications

- High school diploma.
- Valid Driver's license B and D.

Knowledge

- Is responsible for the transportation and guidance of the clients with the main focus on their independence and safety.
- Monitors the clients and reports changes in behavior immediately to **Coordinator**.
- Under general supervision of the Faraja Day center Coordinator, performs a variety of work in general and in support of the clients scheduled program.
- Upkeep the Faraja's vehicle (Bus and Car) external and internal
- Inspects Faraja's vehicles and checks gas, oil, water and all lights, brakes, and safety equipment before and after driving;
- Actively guides group activities assigned to him/her.
- Observe the clients in the bus and within the building and report observations to Psychiatric Aides on a daily basis.
- Support with outside errands, to provide transportation for kitchen grocery shopping.
- Preferably 3 years or more experience in Bus driving.

Social Skills

A service-oriented, positive and appropriate attitude is required. Requires well-developed social skills and self-confidence is necessary. Ability to work independently, as well as in a group. Ability to peacefully solve problems where so required.
